The Adventure Program

Troop 171 has a great history of adventure trips as well as regular monthly campouts. Here is a summary of **PROPOSED** trips and activities for the summer of 2010.

MARK ANY TRIPS THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO ATTEND:

Flaming Gorge: This one is for everyone. This is one of the best chances to earn merit badges and rank advancements. We need a large number of parents to be merit badge counselors!

Micro Adventure: This trip is designed for Scouts who are new to the troop and backpacking.

Mini Adventure: The challenge increased for this adventure. Mini Adventures are open to Scouts ages 12 to 14. They can involve backpacking or canoeing. They are usually a week in length and involve hiking between 20 and 40 miles. Past trips have been in Colorado and Utah.

Mini Adventure Plus: This is the high end of the Mini Adventure level. These trips are open to Scouts ages 13-15.

High Adventure: The fun just keeps coming your way with High Adventure. This is for Scouts ages 14 and up.

High Adventure Plus: This will be the level for the big ones. Life and Eagle Scouts only! Previous adventure trip experience REQUIRED! Age range from 14 to 17. Past trips for High Adventure and High Adventure Plus include scuba diving in Florida, backpacking and canoeing in Alaska, winter ski mountaineering in Yellowstone, and backpacking in Utah, Colorado and Wyoming! Previous adventure trip experience REQUIRED!

Trip Requirements: All adventure trips have specific trip requirements. These include Monday meeting participation, monthly campout participation, advancement, and trip planning meeting participation. Check the permission slips for exact requirements for each trip.

TETANUS NOTE: Tetanus inoculation required for all participants for Mini and High Adventure trips where medical care would be delayed.

- Scout Requirements: Meeting attendance, campouts, advancement, mb's

High Adventures (Scouts ages 14 to 17 at the time of the trip only)

_____ Paria Canyon Backpack (40 miles) – space available basis depending on permits.

- Estimated Cost: \$250 per Scout or adult

- Dates: **March 20 - 30, 2010** (trip window depending on reservation)

_____ Alaska High Adventure

- Estimated Cost: \$1800 - \$2000 per Scout or adult (dependent upon airfare, van rental, fuel and outfitter fees)

- Dates: **Depart June 20 – 23 and return July 4 - 7, 2010.** The exact dates in this window will be decided after we get numbers and confer with travel agent and outfitters. Two week trip.

- Scout Requirements: LIFE and EAGLE Scouts ONLY! Other requirements include meeting attendance, campouts, and advancement, mb's.
